

Chapter 102 Requirements for Ag Buildings/Manure Storages

Under 1 acre of disturbed area

- May need township approvals and meet township stormwater requirements
- District application and associated fees with the **erosion and sediment control plan**

1 acre or more of disturbed area

- May need township approvals and meet township stormwater requirements
- District application and associated fees with the **erosion and sediment control plan**
- National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (**NPDES**) Permit application (will be required - an engineer will be needed to complete forms and do stormwater calculations)

NPDES Application – Notice of Intent (NOI)

Township and county notification letters and proof of receipt

PNHP – PA Natural Heritage Program (the old PNDI)

Application Checklist

Plan & narrative for Post Construction Stormwater Best Management Practices

Erosion and Sediment Control Plan & narrative

NPDES requirements with submission – will need to plan ahead.

General permits usually take about 60 to 90 days to obtain.

Individual permits may take a year or more to obtain.

- Fee for in non-special protection watersheds - General Permit = \$500
- Fee for special protected watersheds Individual Permit = \$1500
- Plus DEP's fee of \$100 per disturbed acre
- Plus District E&S review fee

Please keep in mind NRCS office will need to work with the engineer to show locations of the manure storage on the set of drawings that will be submitted.

KEEP IN MIND PLOWING AND TILLING OPERATIONS ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE A CONSERVATION PLAN WITH AN EROSION AND SEDIMENT CONTROL PLAN

E&S BMPs – will be Temporary or permanent depending on the activity
