COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE

New for 2022, the Franklin County Conservation District has established the Ernie Turner Scholarship Fund. The District has renamed its scholarship fund to extend Ernie's legacy for his long-time stewardship and protection of Franklin County's natural resources. Ernie served as FCCD's manager from 1982-2012. Profits from the annual golf tournament have enabled the Conservation District to offer scholarships for the upcoming school year. **The scholarship amount varies based on golf tournament participation and donations** and is open to all students residing in Franklin County, who have graduated high school and wish to advance their education within a field with an environmental concentration, including but not limited to: Agriculture, Agri-Business, Horticulture, Environmental Science, Fisheries, Forestry, Geo-Environmental Studies, Land Use Planning, Conservation of Natural Resources, Surveying, Wildlife Conservation, Environmental Biology.

Scholarship monies will be awarded each year. The scholarships will be offered to college students who meet ALL the requirements listed below and are chosen as recipients by the Franklin County Conservation District Board of Directors. The recipients will be notified by mail as early as July.

Applications can be obtained by calling the District office Monday through Friday (7:00 AM to 3:30 PM) at 717-264-5499 OR students can print their own application forms and supporting materials from the District's website at: www.franklinccd.org (click on "Education" then "Scholarships"). Applications must be submitted by **June 6, 2022**.

Student Eligibility:

1. High School Graduate who resides in Franklin County
2. Attending a college or university in the United States majoring in field with an environmental concentration.
3. Open to 4-year students – Freshmen, Sophomores, Juniors or Seniors
4. If applying for future scholarships, student should have a C+ or higher average in order to be eligible.

Student Application Needs to Include the Following:

1. Application
2. Written statement of financial need
3. A copy of latest college or high school transcripts
4. Written essay of why you have chosen this major and career goals
5. Recommendation letter
6. Copy of acceptance letter (*If Freshman*)
