COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE!

For the 20th consecutive year, the Franklin County Conservation District will offer scholarships for the upcoming school year. **The scholarship amount varies based on golf tournament participation and donations.** Scholarship application is open to all students who currently reside in Franklin County or have resided for a majority of their lives. If you have graduated (or are graduating) high school and wish to advance your education within a field with an environmental concentration, then this scholarship may be for you! Fields of study include, but are not necessarily limited to: Agriculture, Agri-Business, Horticulture, Environmental Science, Fisheries, Forestry, Geo-Environmental Studies, Land Use Planning, Conservation of Natural Resources, Surveying, Wildlife Conservation, and Environmental Biology.

Scholarship monies will be awarded each year. The scholarships will be offered to college students who meet ALL the requirements listed below and are chosen as recipients by the Franklin County Conservation District Board of Directors. The recipients will be notified by mail as early as July.

Applications can be obtained by calling the District office Monday through Friday (7:00 AM to 3:30 PM) at 717-264-5499 **OR** students may download and print their own application forms and supporting materials via our website (www.franklinccd.org) or by using this LINK.

Applications must be submitted by **June 12, 2026**. Applications may be hand delivered to our office OR sent electronically to Rhoda Crider at rcrider@franklinccd.org.

Student Eligibility:

1. High School Graduate who resides in Franklin County and has been accepted by a college or university
2. Attending a college or university in the United States majoring in a field with an environmental concentration.
3. Open to 4-year students – Freshmen, Sophomores, Juniors or Seniors
4. If applying for future scholarships, student should have a C+ or higher average in order to be eligible.

Student Application MUST INCLUDE the following:

1. Application
2. Written statement of financial need
3. A copy of latest college or high school transcript
4. Written essay of why you have chosen this major and career goals
5. Recommendation letter
6. Copy of acceptance letter (*if you will be a Freshman*)
